



CHANDLER PARKS BOARD MEETING

MARCH 3rd, 2016

Meeting called to order by Todd Hurt @ 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Dockery, Cupp, Hurt, Burnett, & Healy. All present.

McDaniels reported that 10 tons of conditioning product needed for fields. Tenbarge at Ft. Branch the only vendor in this area. \$ 3500.00 for them to deliver product does not include labor to spread the product. The CPS, Inc. will get volunteers to install product on the fields.

McDaniels also reported that both batting cages and the fences are in need of repair. Discussion took place on \$1800.00 to replace one horse shoe, clay bricks but there is a security problem with children hanging and climbing on the batting cages. Clay bricks for all 4 fields would run between \$500.00 and \$1000.00. Over hangs are in need of repair.

Since there was reported problems last year the CPS, Inc., group will send a representative once a month to keep the Parks Board informed.

They are looking to have a kickball league, Church leagues, and Adult leagues this year. The inclusion of children programs will start in 2017.

Todd Hurt reported that he may be able to get a donation to get the fence repaired.

Batting cage: Chris made the comment that he has a net and hardware but does not have a pole.

Concession stand need to see what's needed and if they are capable of starting the season.

Cupp made the motion to accept the contract with Chandler Sports Park, Inc.

Seconded by Burnett. Motion passed.

Continued discussion on the fields. McDaniel requested \$ 4000.00 for product for 2 fields and an additional \$ 200.00 - \$ 500.00 for bricks.

Cupp made the motion for the \$ 4500.00 but purchase is not to exceed this limit.

Seconded by Dockery. Motion passed.

Wendy reported the locks have been changed except for the locks at the small park due to they are large commercial locks although no one knows for sure who has keys to them. She presented Todd with the old locks and the new keys for the new lock installed at the Sports Park. One key was given to Chris McDaniel of Chandler Sports Park, Inc. and one key will be kept at the town hall for the maintenance



department's use. Police have been responsible for opening and closing the bathrooms at the small parks. Normally they are closed in late October and winterized. Depends on the weather in the spring when they are reopened. But it was suggested that the bathrooms be available starting within 2 weeks.

Todd will contact Vectren about how to protect their meters from vandals.

Small park bathroom doors have been replaced where they are not able to be kicked in and they need to be painted. Should be an industrial grade paint.

Wendy reported that the concrete has been removed from the skate park. The switch for the generator no one knows if it has been installed. The utility department will continue to help with small maintenance issue as they have always done. Any large repair a work order will have to be requested. The maintenance department needs to know the areas to mow this summer at the Sport Parks. It was discussed the CPS, Inc., will mow inside the fenced areas the rest will be maintained by the utility department. The large park is normally mowed on Wednesday, or Thursday with the small park being mowed on Thursday or Friday depending on the weather.

The slide and monkey bars will be removed once the weather allows.

Signage: \$ 14.00 for Property Rules: No alcohol, no drugs, no smoking no weapons.

4 Better Chandler: have set up a schedule of events for 2016. Asked the parks board to come up with a small project to be funded. One of the events is a clean up for Memorial weekend another end of August Day of Service. Warrick County Community Foundation has offered to provide funds for a project. Each board member was asked to think about this and bring with them to our next scheduled meeting on March 10th.

The flooding issues at the small park Kim is going to contact Grover and see if the storm water board will address this issue.

Discussion held on trails project for the area around the community center.

Cupp made the motion to adjourn at 7:32 p.m.

Hurt seconded motion carried adjourned until March 10th, 6 p.m.
