



Obtaining a Personal Protection Permit (Handgun Permit)

All gun permits are done online at:

The process for obtaining a handgun permit requires multiple steps:

- Complete the online application at the aforementioned website address.
- Contact Identogo to schedule an appointment to have your fingerprints taken. You may call them at 877-472-6917, or you can schedule an appointment (and view location listings and other information) through their website at <http://www.identogo.com/FP/Indiana.aspx>. At your appointment to be fingerprinted, Identogo will collect the state fee for your handgun permit; you should receive a receipt that shows you have completed the fingerprinting process and paid the state fee.
- Bring your receipt from Identogo to the Chandler Police Department, where you will be required to pay the local permit fee. Upon review and acceptance of your application by the Chandler Police Department, your application will be submitted for consideration to the Indiana State Police. Once the application is approved by the State, they will mail your permit to the address listed on your application.

Indiana Handgun Permit Fees (current as of Jan. 2014, based on Warrick County residence):

- 4-year hunt/target – \$5 state, \$10 local
- 4-year personal protection – \$30 state, \$10 local
- Dealer's personal protection permit – fee exempt
- Life hunt/target (no current license) – \$25 state, \$50 local
- Life hunt/target (w/current license) – \$20 state, \$40 local
- Life personal protection (no current license) – \$75 state, \$50 local
- Life personal protection (w/current license) – \$60 state, \$40 local
- Retired Corrections Officer – fee exempt
- Retired Police Officer – fee exempt
