Town of Chandler Council Special Meeting Minutes

The Chandler Town Council special meeting was called to order November 29, 2021, at the Chandler Town Hall, 401 E. Lincoln Ave. at 5:30 p.m.

Brad presented options for a first phase on the trails project. Brad and the council discussed starting with the S. State St. connector, Cherry St. connector and bridge, ball field loop, flow trails, and hike return trails. Tonya suggested including signs at this phase since the directions will help encourage use of the new trails and the council agreed. The resulting project estimate is \$246,420. Brian confirmed we have \$80,000 budgeted in the CCD fund and we can apply for additional appropriations in the EDIT fund.

Brad mentioned he was busy working on a grant for USI today but will start on ours tomorrow. He will need copies of deeds and a list of easements. He asked the council to help collect support letters to improve the application. The application will be due on Wednesday at 4pm. Sandy asked about setting up a fund for donations and Brian mentioned we already have a park donation fund established that can be used.


