

Storm Tree/Limb Policy

In the event of a storm, intense winds, and ice storm all utility employees will abide by the following set of guidelines and/or rules for tree and limb obstructions.

- Any down Tree/Limb obstructing the road in Town limits will be pushed immediately once informed. Obstruction should be pushed back safely to the property it came from.
- If there is a tornado warning or extreme lightning, On Call personnel will wait until the event has subsided before removing Tree/Limb from roadway.
- Tree/Limb will NOT be removed off any structures, vehicles, wires and/or powerlines.
- Employees should contact Vectren when Tree/Limb is laying on powerline. Can be pushed off the side of road once safely removed from powerline or line is terminated from Vectren.
- Tree/Limb will be safely removed from any Town sidewalk the following day without further damaging customer's property.
- On Call personnel will NOT remove any Tree/Limb from Town sidewalk during said event.
- Tree/Limbs can be hauled off at Director's discretion.
- Tree/Limbs that are being hauled off can only be a maximum of 8" round and maximum length of 6'.
- Tree/Limbs that are being hauled off shall be neatly stacked on edge of road right of way. NOT in the street.
- We will NOT haul off Tree/Limbs that are placed in any container or box.
- We will NOT haul off any other debris such as tree stumps, root balls, construction materials, electronics, trash, leaves and/or mulch.
