Chandler MS4 Stormwater Board Meeting Minutes

The Chandler MS4 Stormwater meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Chandler Town Hall.

Roll Call, Present; Elder, Williams, Mooney and MS4 Coordinator Bell.

Bell welcomed newly appointed member Adam Mooney. Adam will complete the term of Tom Rainey that will expire 12.31.27. It was noted that Warrick County SWCD awarded Chandler as The Conservation Partner of the Year at their annual meeting for the Nature Park and the DNR Wetland Mitigation Program.

Minutes: Motion was made by Elder and seconded by Williams to accept the minutes from the November 25, 2024 meeting. Motion passed with Mooney abstaining. There was no meeting in January due to lack of a quorum.

Report of the Storm Water Coordinator: Matt McGuyer, the new Stormwater Tech started January 5 and has already completed the MS4 Compliance and Enforcement sponsored by the NPDES Training Institute and received certification. Progress on Work Orders was shared.

Old Business: The Stormwater Budget for 2025 was presented and there was discussion on the possibility of a \$1 increase in the Stormwater Fee that would coincide with the proposed water increase. Elder expressed concern of how the rate increase might effect businesses and Bell said he would do some research as to how other communities handled stormwater fees for businesses. Bell shared that there is an on going discussion with IDEM concerning SWPPP's that they are requesting from our Chandler Utilities working in Warrick County.

New Business: Bell provided an update on future developments and the need for Stormwater conveyance along Inderrieden Road. It was noted that our Annual IDEM Report is due April 1.

Elder made the motion to recess until the next meeting, March 24, 2025 and Mooney seconded the motion. Motion passed.
